

Privacy Policy additional – written by Friends of the Earth

Introduction

This is an addition to the “Platform Privacy Policy” linked in the pages where it is relevant. All of the below privacy policy information should be viewed in the context of The Action Network Privacy Policy - “Platform Privacy Policy” - herein ‘ANPP’. It aims to provide further clarity and transparency on top of what is available in the ANPP.

Friends of the Earth is the collective name for Friends of the Earth Trust, registered charity 281681, company number 1533942, and Friends of the Earth Limited, company number 1012357, both of which may use your information. In both cases the registered office is at 1st Floor, The Printworks, 139 Clapham Road, London SW9 0HP.

Powered By

This privacy policy is applicable to all actions, pages, events or the like, where you see the name “Powered by Friends of the Earth” in the template. This means that the action, page, event or the like, has been created by a group external to Friends of the Earth– herein known as the ‘sponsoring group’ - hosted and maintained by The Action Network, and *Powered by Friends of the Earth* through a partnership between The Action Network and Friends of the Earth. Data security

Friends of the Earth Limited take data security very seriously. This is why we have outlined the following scenarios for transparency with those taking part in our actions:

Common scenarios

By default, when you opt in to communication to the sponsor of the action, your data will be held securely by the platform owner; in this case see the ANPP. As this service is currently being developed, the sponsoring group may remove data from The Action Network at the end of this period. Friends of the Earth cannot be responsible for the theft, destruction or inadvertent disclosure of your personal information whether it is held online or off-line.

Sharing data with Friends of the Earth

Through the system manager, your data **can** be access by Friends of the Earth but they will not pass on your details anywhere else nor use them to get in touch with you. If the option to opt in to communications from Friends of the Earth is added in the future, there will be specific checkbox that will explicitly reference Friends of the Earth and the specific communication channel that is relevant. Friends of the Earth takes steps to ensure that access to personal information is restricted to employees who need it. All Friends of the Earth employees who handle personal information are kept up-to-date on our security and privacy practices. Our employees are notified and reminded about the importance we place on privacy, and what they can do to ensure your information is protected.

We cannot, however, be responsible for the theft, destruction or inadvertent disclosure of your personal information whether Friends of the Earth hold it on or off-line.

How is the information used

By default you are not subscribed or opted into communications from anyone. If you indicate that you are interested in being communicated with by the sponsor of the action then they may communicate with you via the channel agreed in the opt-in statement. This is to let you know about similar things you might be interested in, results of campaigns and updates. This is down to the discretion of the sponsoring group. You can unsubscribe at any time.
